

CSC Tennis Rules and Regulations

A) Members

- 1) Senior members are members aged 18 years and above, paying full Senior contribution fee.
- 2) Junior members are members from age 4 to 17 years paying full Junior contribution fee.

B) General Rules of conduct.

- 1) The proper standards of decency should be observed at all times.
- 2) The proper tennis shoes and outfit must be worn on the tennis courts.
- 3) Eating on the tennis courts is not allowed and all waste should be placed in the appropriate baskets.
- 4) Decisions and instructions by the members of the board, relevant committee members, trainers and bar attendants should be followed and respected at all times.

C) Court Rules (General)

- 1) Playing times for singles is 45 minutes and for doubles playing time is 90 min.
- 2) In case of singles, both membership badges should be placed on the reserving board and at the appropriate reserved time slot.
- 3) In case of doubles, all four membership badges should be placed on the reserving board and at the appropriate time slot.

D) Courts

- 1) Court no. 1 (Irene) is available for junior members till 6.00 pm (18.00)
- 2) Court no. 2 is available for junior members till 7.30 pm (19.30)
- 3) Court no. 3 is available to the tennis trainer and has priority. If the trainer is not present, this court can be used by both junior and senior members, same rules as courts 2 and 5.
- 4) Court no. 4 (Center court) is available for junior members till 6.00 pm (18.00)
- 5) Court no. 5 is available for junior members till 7.30 pm (19.30)
- 6) Court no. 6 (Iyo) is available to the tennis trainer and has priority. If the trainer is not present, this court can be used by both junior and senior members, same rules as courts 2 and 5.

E) Court Reserving system

- 1) At the moment of reserving a court at least 1 (one) player for singles and at least 2 (two) players for doubles must be present. Players are not allowed to leave the premises after reserving a court.
- 2) If, at any moment, the time on the board begins to run and the players are not on the reserved court within **10** minutes; other players not having played yet, are allowed to reserve said court. The players having used said court during the preceding period of time, are allowed to continue if there are no other players, as mentioned above, however said players should again put their membership badges at the new time slot.
- 3) In principle a court can not be reserved for two successive periods of time by the same players. Singles; 45 min. and Doubles; 90 min. Those members playing doubles can not reserve a third time slot to play a singles game if all courts are occupied and should yield the court to others.
- 4) Junior members are allowed to play on courts available to senior members. However, said courts may be claimed by a senior member right away.
- 5) On courts reserved for senior members, junior members are allowed to play with senior members till 7.30 pm (19.30).
- 6) It is not allowed to reserve an occupied court of your own preference, while there is one or more other courts available.
- 7) If it has rained and the courts are wet and one or more couples dried a court, the ones that dried the court have the right to use double the normal period.
- 8) It is strongly prohibited to either remove or change a player's membership badge from the board without permission of the corresponding player and/or the bar attendant or a board member.

F) Introduction of a player

- 1) A guest player can be introduced by a member a max. of three (3) times a month.
- 2) The Introduction fee is Nafils. 15,00 per person each time and has to be paid cash at the bar in advance.
